Since the Fall of 2006, UVMI has been a part of helping Pastors Augusto and Milagros Policarpo as they reach out to the people of San Juan de Lurigancho. This is an impoverished zone in Lima, Peru inhabited by over 1 million people. These pastors continue to carry the Good News of the Gospel, coupled with tangible humanitarian works, to a people that have little hope of being able to rise above their present circumstances in life. Their ministry includes an alcohol and drug restoration center, an outreach program to needy women, an extensive children's ministry, prison ministry and a local church. The name of the church **LIGHT IN THE DARKNESS** describes the spiritual atmosphere where they live and work. The photo to the left (below) shows the miles and miles of makeshift dwellings in this area. Their church and ministry provide a place of refuge, hope and comfort to the weary. We can see in the above photo Pastor Milagros with some of the children who participated in the Vacation Bible School held during the 2 week school break in July. We are thankful that UVMI can partner with this ministry and look forward to more opportunities to help these faithful pastors in the futures.
