As we look back on the year of 2013, we are thankful for the opportunities presented to us to reach out and add to the ministries that the Lord has connected us to. Because of you and the partners of UVMI many lives were touched by the love of Jesus that you demonstrated through your financial giving and through your prayers.

In Jamaica, you helped Pastors Errol and Peggy James of Claremont, St Anne's Parish continue with much-needed construction projects on their Basic School building. This school provides over 90 children with a strong Christian early childhood education. As we focus on the purpose and vision of this Basic School, we see single mothers, young couples, parents and grandparents, who bring their precious little ones to this school because it is a safe place. We have watched Pastors Errol and Peggy take care of these children as if they are their very own. The teachers and staff have created an atmosphere where the children receive excellent academic training and healthy meals. Most of all, they are taught daily principles of the Word of God, providing them a strong spiritual foundation for the years to come. This seed that you have planted is growing, and bringing forth a great harvest in the lives of the children and their families and the community.

In Peru the partners of UVMI reached out during the year to Pastors Augusto and Milagros Policarpo of San Juan de Lurigancho, in Lima, Peru. We were able to help with much needed school uniforms and supplies for the Pastors' family, personal family needs and something extra for the family for Christmas. This year was the 8<sup>th</sup> year that we were able to help the ministry in Peru by sending funds for the annual Children's Christmas Outreach, reaching out to over 100 children with gifts, food, and to point them to the true meaning of Christmas. As we have communicated before, for many of the children, this is the only time that they will celebrate Christmas, as they live in one of the largest slums in South America.

Goals for 2014 We have an open invitation to return to Costa Rica to minister in the churches that we are in relationship with there. Vicki has been invited to hold a women's conference.

In December we were blessed to have a visit to our home in Orlando from our dear friends from Jamaica, Pastors Errol and Peggy James. It was a great time of fellowship, and also a time to make plans about how we can be more involved with teaching and training the churches in Jamaica, and to bring more teams to build and evangelize. We are working with Pastor Errol and a friend who is a pastor in the port city of Limon, Costa Rica, to sponsor a team consisting of some of the young people and members of

the churches in Jamaica, to go to this predominately English-speaking, Caribbean-descent population who live on the east coast of Costa Rica.

We are praying about taking a small group to Peru, to encourage the pastors there and to also see how we can be more effective in helping the ministry.

**Prayer Focus**: We would ask that you would pray with us about these upcoming plans and that God's timing, and direction and provision will be manifested and made clear.

We look forward to the new things that God has in store for each of us this year of 2014.
